SEXUAL BEHAVIOR

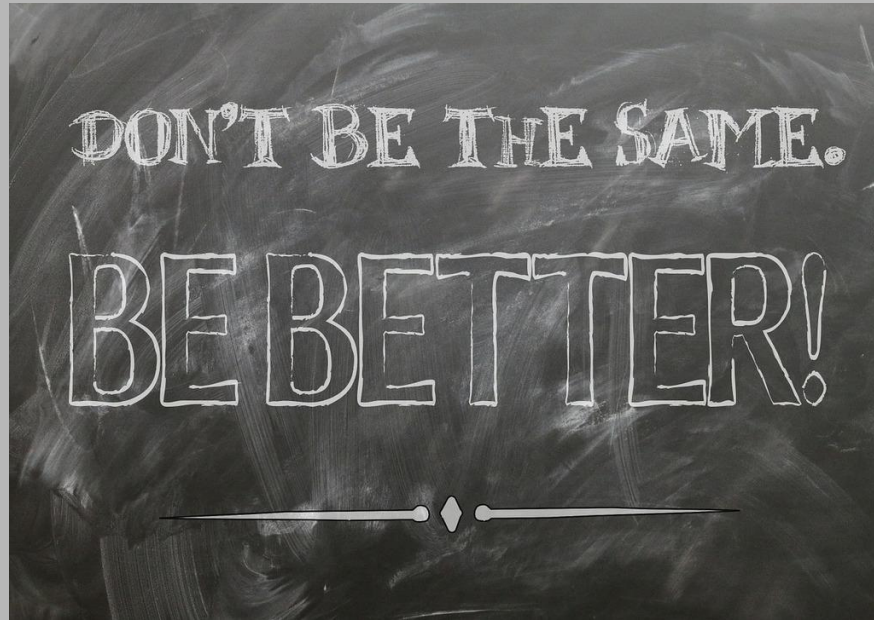
Broad spectrum of behavior in which humans display their sexuality

INTIMACY

Mental, emotional or physical closeness such as a personal remark, a warm or familiar setting or detailed knowledge.

SEXUAL RESPONSIBILITY

Making informed decisions and safer sex choices



DISEASE PREVENTION VS. BIRTH CONTROL

Disease Prevention: stops/protects against the transmission of sexually transmitted diseases/infections

Ex: condoms, female condoms, dental dam ect.

Birth Control: prevents pregnancy from happening

Ex- the pill, spermicide, IUD, the patch ect.

Sexually Transmitted Infections

STI: An infection transmitted through sexual contact, caused by bacteria, viruses, or parasites (also known as STD'S)

Bacterial: a can be treated and often cured with antibiotics. Some bacterial STDs include chlamydia, gonorrhea,, and syphilis.

Viral: can be controlled, but not cured. If you get a viral STD, you will always have it. Some viral STDs include HIV, genital herpes, genital warts, human papillomavirus (HPV), hepatitis B

Parasites: an organism that lives on a host, can be cured by topical creams ex- pubic lice
